Please choose one of the following two options for reporting your 2008 Annual Church Profile:

Option 1: Take advantage of the Internet application, Southern Baptist Directory Services (SBDS), for entering your 2008 Annual Church Profile (ACP) information. It is suggested that the paper response sheet be completed prior to online entry in order to expedite the process.

SBDS **requires** either Microsoft Internet Explorer version 5.0 or greater or Netscape Navigator version 4.0 or greater. Cookies must be enabled and pop-up windows allowed. Adobe Acrobat Reader is required for some reports and can be downloaded for FREE at www.Adobe.com

ITEM DEFINITIONS for 2008 ANNUAL CHURCH PROFILE

The **2007-2008 reporting year** is the 12 month period included in this report. In many cases this will correspond to the associational year. Be sure to report a full 12 months of data where cumulative information is requested. Membership and enrollment information should be given as of the last day of the reporting year.

Largest Ethnic Grp: White (Non-Hispanic), Black (African-American), Hispanic, Native American, Korean, Chinese or Other
Year Organized: Year congregation constituted for the first time as a church. If a church-type mission, year the congregation organized as a mission.

Church: a body of baptized believers that has formally constituted into an autonomous church. (It is self-determining, self-sustaining, and self-propagating.)

Church-type Mission: a body of baptized believers having a distinct identity that meets regularly for worship, engages in Bible study and evangelism, and provides opportunity for stewardship and fellowship, but has not yet constituted as an autonomous church. (It cannot be described as self-determining, self-sustaining, and self-propagating.)

1. Total members should be the total of both Resident Members and Nonresident Members added together. Do NOT include in Items 1 and 2 persons who are members of any church-type missions which your congregation may be sponsoring. (These members should appear on the ACP completed by the church-type mission.)
2. Resident members are those members who live close enough to your congregation to attend. Do NOT include members from any church-type missions which your congregation may be sponsoring. (These members should appear on the ACP completed by the church-type mission.)
3. Total number of baptisms during the 2007-2008 reporting year. **(Add Items 3a through 3g.)**
 - a. Number of children, 5 years of age and under, who were baptized during the 2007-2008 reporting year.
 - b. Number of children, 6-8 years of age, who were baptized during the 2007-2008 reporting year.
 - c. Number of children, 9-11 years of age, who were baptized during the 2007-2008 reporting year.
 - d. Number of youth, 12-17 years of age, who were baptized during the 2007-2008 reporting year.
 - e. Number of adults, 18-29 years of age, who were baptized during the 2007-2008 reporting year.
 - f. Number of adults, 30-59 years of age, who were baptized during the 2007-2008 reporting year.
 - g. Number of adults, 60 years of age and over, who were baptized during the 2007-2008 reporting year.
4. Number of people who became members of your congregation by ways other than baptism (letter of transfer, statement) during the 2007-2008 reporting year.
5. Average number of persons in the primary worship service(s) of your congregation. For many congregations the primary worship service(s) is on Sunday morning. If weekly attendance is not kept, give attendance for the last Sunday of the 2007-2008 reporting year.
6. In what year did your current senior pastor start work at your congregation? If your congregation does NOT presently have a senior pastor, leave this item blank. Do not count as senior pastor someone who is just preaching until the congregation finds a senior pastor.
7. Total number of all persons enrolled in the Sunday School (SS) ministry or any similar ongoing strategy, including small groups and cell groups (j). Base enrollment on the last regular meeting of the 2007-2008 reporting year. **Add Items 7a through 7j.** Include officers and teachers in the totals. Persons should be counted in the total enrollment (7a-7j) only one time.
 - a. Number of babies/children, kindergarten and under. Include workers. Also include home visitation ministries to preschoolers, such as First Contact, Cradle Roll, etc.
 - b. Number of children, 6-11 years of age or grades 1-6. Include workers.
 - c. Number of youth, 12-17 years of age or grades 7-12. Include workers.
 - d. Number of young adults, 18-24 years of age (or high school graduation through 24 years of age). Include workers. Also include any ministry to adults (of any age) who are away for extended periods of time, such as the military or the Adults Away program.
 - e. Number of young adults, 25-34 years of age. Include workers.
 - f. Number of adults, 35-54 years of age. Include workers.
 - g. Number of adults, 55-64 years of age. Include workers.
 - h. Number of adults, 65 years of age and over. Include workers. Also include any ministry to homebound adults, such as the Sunday School Homebound program.
 - i. Number of Sunday School general officers (or persons involved in the administrative duties) who are not already counted elsewhere in the Sunday School enrollment. Include the pastor and staff as appropriate.
 - j. Number of persons enrolled in other ongoing Bible study groups including cell groups not included above in Items 7a-7i. These include cell groups, home groups, apartment/multi-housing groups and ongoing Bible study for special groups (such as Special Education classes, Sunday Schools held at various times/places, etc.). If an enrollment figure is not kept, please give the best estimate of the total number of persons who ever attend on a regular basis.

8. Average number of persons attending Sunday School (Items 7a-7j) each week during the 2007-2008 reporting year. Be sure to include cell/other groups (which were reported in Item 7j) in this number.

9. Number of persons who were enrolled in your congregation's Vacation Bible School(s). Do NOT include VBS enrollments from any church-type missions which your congregation may be sponsoring/assisting. (These enrollments should appear on the ACP completed by the church-type mission.)

10. Total number of all persons (**counted only once**) who participated in one or more Discipleship Training studies, activities, or groups during the 2007-2008 reporting year. Include all age-level workers and General Officers. This Total includes both ongoing/continuous groups and short-term activities. **Persons should be counted only once** regardless of how many studies in which they participated. **(Add Items 10a through 10d.)**

- a. Number of preschool children (kindergarten and under) who participated in one or more Discipleship Training studies, activities, or groups. Include workers. This number includes both ongoing/continuous groups and short-term activities. Persons should be counted only once regardless of how many studies in which they participated.
- b. Number of children (6-11 years of age or grades 1-6) who participated in one or more Discipleship Training studies, activities, or groups. Include workers. This number includes both ongoing/continuous groups and short-term activities. Persons should be counted only once regardless of how many studies in which they participated.
- c. Number of youth (12-17 years of age or grades 7-12) who participated in one or more Discipleship Training studies, activities, or groups. Include workers. This number includes both ongoing/continuous groups and short-term activities. Persons should be counted only once regardless of how many studies in which they participated.
- d. Number of adults (18 years of age or high school graduation and over) who participated in one or more Discipleship Training studies, activities, or groups. Include workers and all General Officers (such as pastor, other staff, DT director, general secretary and any other general officers). This number includes both ongoing/continuous groups and short-term activities. Persons should be counted only once regardless of how many studies in which they participated.

11. Total participants in Music Ministry. Persons may be counted more than once (counted for each group in which they participated). Base enrollment on the last regular meeting of the 2007-2008 reporting year. **(Add Items 11a through 11e.)**

- a. Number of choir members, 3 years of age through kindergarten, plus all leaders, accompanists and age group coordinators.
- b. Number of choir members, 6-11 years of age or grades 1-6, plus leaders, accompanists and age group coordinators.
- c. Number of choir members, 12-17 years of age or grades 7-12, plus leaders, accompanists, and age group coordinators.
- d. Number of choir members, 18 years of age (or high school graduation) and over, plus leaders, and accompanists. Include members of any separate senior adult choirs. Include music director, church pianist, and church organist.
- e. Number of persons who participate in handbells (include choir chimes groups), vocal ensembles, and instrumental group(s), plus leaders and accompanists.

12. Number of individuals (males and females) in your congregation who gave of their time to physically participate in mission projects (such as World Changers, Disaster Relief, Baptist Builders, Acteens Activators, Volunteer Connection, construction, church planting, evangelism, Bible clubs, surveys, etc.). This does NOT include giving money to mission projects, or collecting or assembling items for ministries to migrants, the incarcerated, or others, etc. The mission projects may have been sponsored by your church, association, state convention, or SBC entity. They may have been conducted within your community, your state (province), the United States and its territories, Canada, or other countries. Persons may be counted more than once (counted for each mission project in which they participated) and this should be reflected in the TOTAL. **(Add Items 12a through 12d.)**

- a. Number of persons (males and females) from your congregation who participated in missions projects conducted in your local community.
- b. Number of persons (males and females) from your congregation who participated in missions projects conducted within your state (province), but outside of your congregation's local community.
- c. Number of persons (males and females) from your congregation who participated in missions projects conducted within the United States and its territories or Canada, but outside of your state (province).
- d. Number of persons (males and females) from your congregation who participated in missions projects conducted outside the United States, its territories, and Canada.

13. Total number of WMU members and leaders enrolled. Base enrollment on the last regular meeting or missions experience of the 2007-2008 reporting year. **(Add Items 13a through 13f.)**

- a. Number of preschoolers, babies through kindergarten, enrolled in Mission Friends. Include teachers in the number.
- b. Number of children, 6-11 years of age or grades 1-6, enrolled in Girls in Action (for girls) and/or Children in Action (for girls and boys). Include leaders in the number.
- c. Number of youth, 12-17 years of age or grades 7-12, enrolled in Acteens (for youth girls) and/or Youth on Missions (for youth girls and boys). Include leaders in the numbers.
- d. Number of adults, 18 years of age (or high school graduation) and over, enrolled in Women on Mission, including Sisters Who Care, and/or Adults on Mission (for women and men). Include collegiate women in Missions Interchange if your congregation has Missions Interchange. Include leaders in the number.
- e. Number of WMU leadership team members. All age-level leaders should be included in the above age-level totals. Leadership team members include: WMU director, assistant WMU director, WMU church-wide missions coordinator, and the coordinator for each age level organization.
- f. Number of persons engaged in ongoing missions involvement sponsored by WMU other than through WMU age-level organizations. This includes ongoing activities such as small groups with a missions focus and ongoing ministries.

14. Total number of all persons enrolled in Men and Boys Mission Education activities (some congregations still refer to these as Brotherhood activities). Base enrollment on the last regular meeting of the 2007-2008 reporting year.

(Add Items 14a through 14c.)

- a. Number of children, 6-11 years of age or grades 1-6, enrolled in Royal Ambassadors. Include leaders such as counselors, RA Director, and RA Committee members.
- b. Number of youth, 12-17 years of age or grades 7-12, enrolled in Challengers (for youth boys). Include leaders such as counselors, Challengers Director, and Challengers Committee members.
- c. Number of men, 18 years of age (or high school graduation) and over, enrolled in Baptist Men. Include leaders and officers such as Baptist Men director and assistant director, and Baptist Men church-wide missions coordinator.

Items 15-23 are financial items. ROUND dollar amounts to nearest whole dollar.

15. Total amount of all money received by the congregation. This amount should be the total of undesignated gifts, designated gifts, and other receipts (may be income from rentals, day school or kindergarten fees, savings, pastoral aid, parking fees, etc.).

16. Total amount of all **undesignated gifts** received by the congregation from individuals. Undesignated receipts are those gifts which the congregation decides how the money will be spent (by use of its budget or some other means). This would probably include regular budget offerings as well as loose monies received in the collection plate.

17. Total amount of all **designated gifts** received by the congregation from individuals for a specific use. Designated receipts are those gifts where the giver requests that the money be spent for a particular purpose. **Examples** of designated gifts include special offerings designated to Lottie Moon Christmas Offering, Annie Armstrong Easter Offering, state missions, building funds, debt retirement, or any other offering or gift designated for a specific use.

18. Total amount of all undesignated and designated funds given to any/all mission causes (Southern Baptist and other mission causes) by the congregation. This includes monies given to: Southern Baptist church-type missions; any associational, state convention, or Southern Baptist Convention ministries (this includes the Cooperative Program); or any other Southern Baptist or non-Southern Baptist mission cause. **(Item 18 should be equal to or larger than the sum of items 19-21.)**

19. Total amount of ALL money given through the Cooperative Program during the 2007-2008 reporting year. Include all channels of contribution of monies that go through the Cooperative Program.

20. Total amount of money given during the 2007-2008 reporting year to the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering for North American Missions.

21. Total amount of money given during the 2007-2008 reporting year to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering for International Missions.

22. Total amount of money that this congregation owed at the end of 2007-2008 reporting year. Be sure to include monies owed for the purchase of congregational property, congregational furniture, mission property, pastor's home, or any other debt from monies borrowed by the congregation.

23. Total value of all property owned by the congregation. This may include property owned by the congregation for a pastor's home, a church-type mission, or any other property owned by the congregation. Use realtor's current estimate of replacement value if possible.

INSTRUCTIONS for COMPLETING the LEADERS WORKSHEET

The leaders worksheet identifies all leadership positions for the 2008 - 2009 ACP cycle. The most recent leader information collected has been included in the worksheet. Follow the steps below to review your leaders and update accordingly. **Please use the address where the leader desires to receive mail pertaining to church business.** Select only the **one** status attribute (Full-time Vocational, Bi-vocational, Interim, Part-time or Volunteer) that best applies to each leadership position. Use the blank form at the end of the worksheet to identify leadership positions filled by more than one person.

USE of LEADER INFORMATION

The names and contact information collected through the ACP process are used to compile the official denominational lists of staff and other positions. Associations, state conventions, and SBC agencies use these names and contact information to communicate with these persons about meetings, services, and products in which they may have an interest. Most persons find these communications to be helpful. Persons receiving such communications may contact the sender and request to be removed from future mailings. At the national level, lists are not made available to individuals or groups outside of the denomination. Congregations are urged to communicate to the leaders whose information they submit the fact that their names/addresses have been submitted for use by denominational entities (association, state, and national).

DEFINITIONS of LEADERSHIP STATUS ATTRIBUTES

Full-time Vocational: Person is employed in the position full-time and considers it their vocation. All (or the majority) of his/her income is from this position. Some may refer to this status as a fully-funded vocational position.

Bivocational: Person is employed at another job in addition to the congregational position and a significant part of his/her income is from the other job. Some may refer to this status as a partially-funded position.

Interim: Person is employed in a position for a short time while the congregation/association seeks someone to fill the position on a regular basis. The interim does not anticipate staying in the position on an on-going (long-term) basis.

Part-time: Person fills a part-time position and receives part-time pay.

Volunteer: Person is filling the position as a volunteer. The person is not given any compensation for his/her work.

STEP 1: Consider the questions below when completing the leaders worksheet.

Is the person still in the leadership position with **incorrect or incomplete** information?

If YES, then mark out the incorrect information and make appropriate changes/additions on the form.

Is **another person** in the leadership position?

If YES, then mark through the previous leader's information and write the current leader's information on the form.

Is the position now **vacant**?

If YES, then mark through the previous leader's information and write vacant beside the position on the form. Leave blank when entering data in SBDS.

Has a vacant leadership position been **filled**?

If YES, then please provide the current leader's information on the form.

Does **more than one person** occupy the leadership position?

If YES, then add the leader(s) to the worksheet using the blank form. Duplicate the blank form as often as needed. Use the names of leadership positions found on the worksheet to identify the leadership positions (such as Senior Pastor, WMU Director, etc.)
